Appearance

Skirts must be knee-length. Girls must not come to school with coloured or bleached hair. All hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back with simple **navy, black** or the school **tartan** hair bands. Make-up and jewellery are not permitted. They are expected to look tidy, with their uniform in good repair. Girls with pierced ears may only wear **small, plain** gold or silver **ball studs** and these must be removed for **all** sport. Ears should be pierced only **at the beginning of a Summer Holiday**. Shoes must be black, polished leather (not patent) and fastened with velcro, lace or buckle. Pumps or heels are **not permitted**. Ankle socks must **cover the ankle**. Sports-style socks are not permitted.

Dress Code
